III. STRATEGIC INFRASTRUCTURE

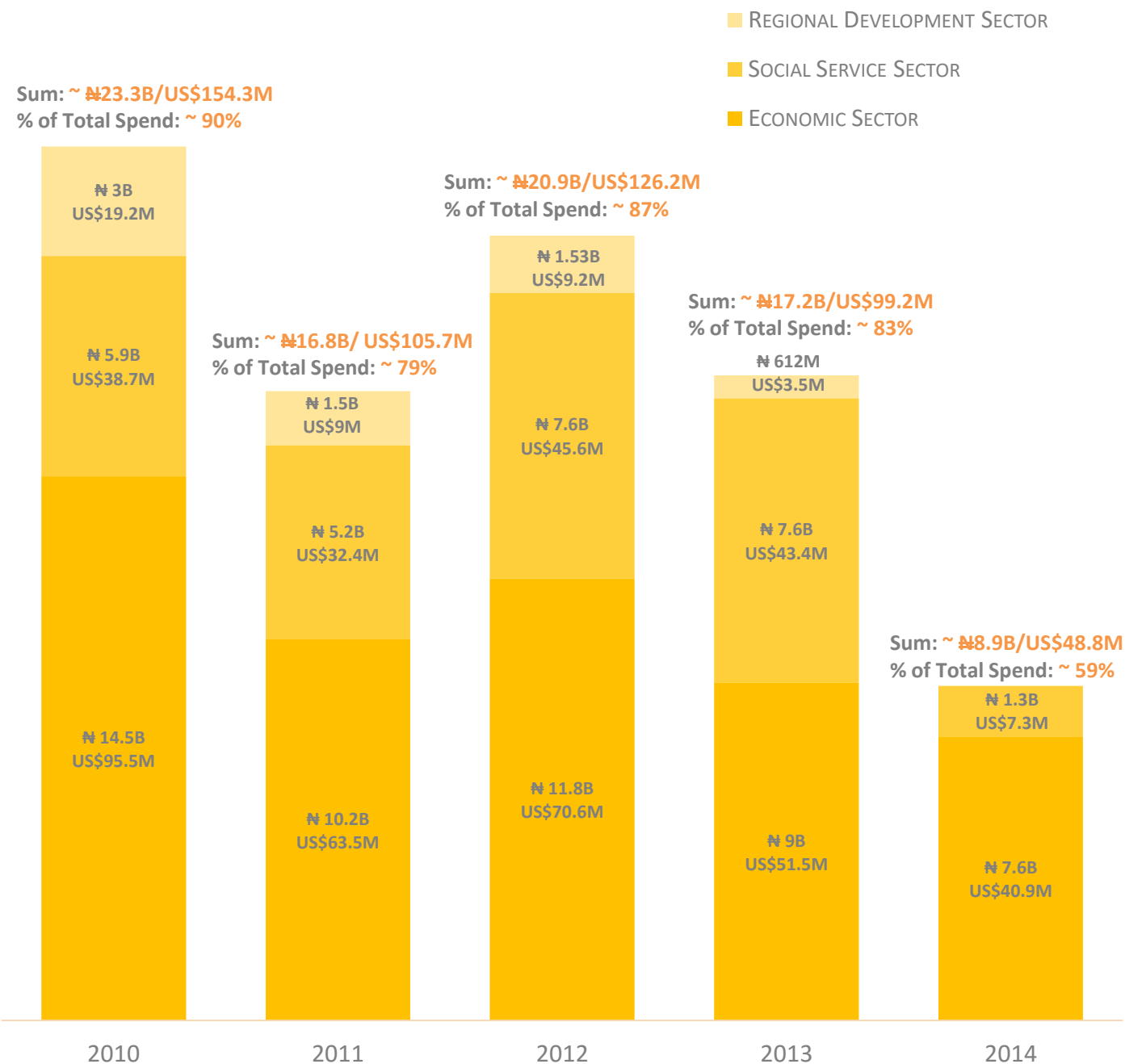
- ✓ Improving supply of electricity to enhance people's well-being and businesses
